Doing "Our Part"

This month in the newsletter I want to take a few lines to speak to you about a phrase that has been heard in Christian circles for many years, but is used incorrectly. The phrase often quoted is; "But God expects me to do my part!" According to the Bible, what is "our part"? In Mark 8:14-21, we see the disciples in a boat with Jesus and they had forgotten to bring enough bread to eat, (they only had one loaf). When Jesus during His teaching used the word "yeast" or "leaven" to describe the damaging effects only a little of the Pharisees' teaching could

have, the disciples assumed that He was upset because they didn't "do their part" in bringing enough bread. Jesus, realizing their thoughts, reminded them of the feeding of the five thousand and the feeding of the four thousand. Jesus reminded them how He had used the very little and how there was plenty left over. Acts 17:25 says that God is not served by human hands as if He needed anything. If God is waiting for you to do "your part", your part is to trust Him to provide for you. If there is anything specific He wants you to do in His plan for providing

for you, He will let you know. Until then, wait on Him to provide and speak to you. We see Peter trying to do "his part" in the garden as he tried to defend Jesus with the sword. If we look at the context, since Jesus had just told them to sell their coats and get a sword, I'm sure that Peter was doing what he thought Jesus wanted him to do, but Jesus said he guessed wrong. In your time of waiting for God to provide, don't guess. Wait in faith that God will provide and that He will speak clearly if there is something He wants you
